- Pregnancy risk factor identification to determine the risk level of your pregnancy and appropriate range for ongoing communication/monitoring
- Educational material including a complimentary book about having a healthy pregnancy and baby
- Personal telephone contact with program staff to address your needs and concerns and to coordinate care with your physician
- Assistance in managing high-risk conditions such as gestational diabetes and preeclampsia

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Special Beginnings[®] A Healthier Start

One out of every nine babies is born preterm. These premature births require extraordinary medical resources, costing more than \$26 billion each year.*

The Special Beginnings maternity program enables early identification of high-risk pregnancies and increased opportunities for interventions that can result in cost savings and better clinical outcomes. Our program provides expectant members with ongoing support and education from early pregnancy until six weeks after delivery, including:

- Identifying risk factors for each pregnancy.
- Providing personal contact from program staff to address needs and concerns; and coordinate care with the member's physician to reinforce the treatment plan.
- Helping manage high-risk conditions such as gestational diabetes and preeclampsia.
- Integrating with other Blue Care Connection programs like Behavioral Health to manage depression or substance abuse; and Lifestyle Management to provide smokers with tobacco cessation services.
- Offering access to other pregnancy-related resources including iPhone[®] apps Duty Calls for new dads and Tot Tracker to help parents track their child's milestones from ages 0-3 years.

Online is another resource that provides information for each week of pregnancy. Members can enroll in Special Beginnings from this site, which can be accessed through Blue Access for Members[™]. Online assessments are available along with a range of educational information, including a video library and a weekly calendar to track baby's development.

The cost savings for high-risk pregnancies managed through Special Beginnings and the Case Management program is double that of pregnancies managed through Case Management alone:

Special Beginnings and Case Management	Case Management only
\$8,000 savings per case	\$4,000 savings per case

Early identification through Special Beginnings allows clinicians to intervene sooner, avoiding costly hospital admissions for threatened preterm labor by arranging for home-based services.
