Formulary Drug Removals -An Important Update.

Effective January 1, 2013, certain medications will be removed from the Caremark formulary drug list. Expenses for prescription drugs that are not on the Caremark formulary drug list are not covered under the Plan. If you continue using one of the those drugs identified as a Formulary Drug Removal after January 1, 2013, you may be required to pay the full cost of the drug. If you are currently using one of these drugs, ask your doctor to choose one of the generic or brand formulary consideration options reflected on the Formulary Drug Removal list.
