The DNoA Preferred Network offers strong network savings that lead to lower out-of-pocket expenses. Benefits of utilizing a contracted dentist in the DNoA Preferred Network include:

- No referral required for specialty dentists; and,
- Contracting dentists will submit claims on your behalf.

Your dental benefits have not changed. This means that you can select a dentist from within or outside the network and coverage will remain at the same benefit level.
