LABOR BULLETIN

Contract Effective Date: June 1, 2017

Contract Expiration Date: May 31, 2021

Under the terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Construction and General Laborers' District Council of Chicago and Vicinity, the 4-year agreement negotiated between the Chicago Area Independent Construction Industry, their Collective Bargaining Representatives and Laborers' International Union of North America, Locals 582 and 1035, provide for a total economic increase as follows:

- Effective June 1, 2017 - \$2.17 per hour
- Effective June 1, 2018 - \$2.24 per hour
- Effective June 1, 2019 - \$2.31 per hour
- Effective June 1, 2020 - \$2.39 per hour

The June 1, 2019 increase provides that \$2.31 per hour be allocated as follows:

- Wages increase \$1.00 per hour to \$43.72 per hour
- Pension increases \$0.85 per hour to \$14.55 per hour
- Welfare increases \$0.28 per hour to \$14.05 per hour
- Training increases \$0.18 per hour to \$0.90 per hour
