

# Laborers International Union of North America Local 582 and Local 1035

## LABOR BULLETIN

Contract Effective Date: June 1, 2017

Contract Expiration Date: May 31, 2021

Under the terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Construction and General Laborers' District Council of Chicago and Vicinity, the 4-year agreement negotiated between various area Associations, their Collective Bargaining Representatives and Laborers' International Union of North America, Locals 582 and 1035, provide for a total economic increase as follows:

Effective June 1, 2017 - \$2.17 per hour

Effective June 1, 2018 - \$2.24 per hour

Effective June 1, 2019 - \$2.31 per hour

Effective June 1, 2020 - \$2.39 per hour

The June 1, 2020 increase provides that \$2.39 per hour be allocated as follows:

Wages increase \$0.68 per hour to \$44.40 per hour

Welfare increases \$0.21 per hour to \$14.26 per hour

Pension increases \$1.50 per hour to \$16.05 per hour

1st six (6) months: 60% of journeyman (base) wages	\$26.64
2nd six (6) months: 70% of journeyman (base) wages	\$31.08
3rd six (6) months: 80% of journeyman (base) wages	\$35.52
4th six (6) months: 90% of journeyman (base) wages	\$39.96
After twenty-four (24) months: 100% of journeyman (base) wages	\$44.40
